Downloading full-text off the Web often takes lots of computer memory. Before starting Netscape, increase Netscape's memory to 10,000. To do this, click once to highlight Netscape 3.0 application on your harddrive. Go up to file on the menu bar and drag down to Get Info. Type 10000 in the Preferred Size window. Close the window.

Many files today are in .pdf file format and you must have Adobe Acrobat Reader 3.0 loaded on your computer before you can download and read them. To get a copy of Adobe Acrobat Reader 3.0, go to the Adobe Web site at <http://www.adobe.com>.
